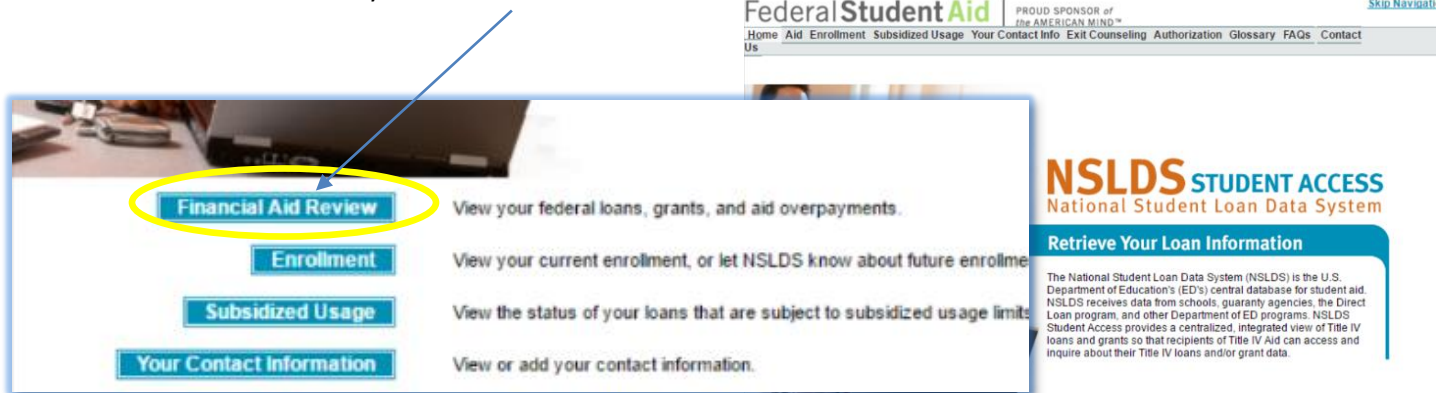


National Student Loan Data System

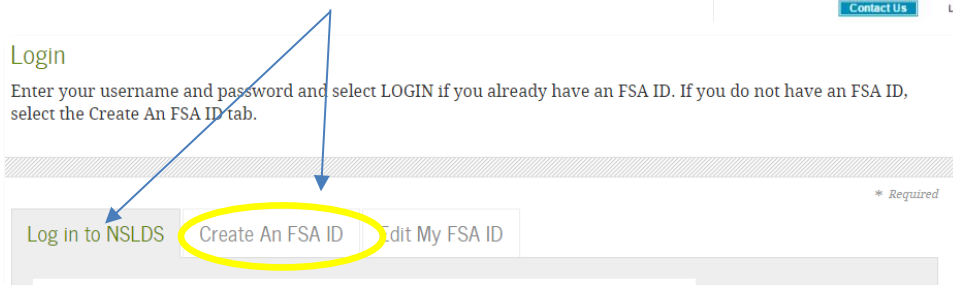
The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) is the U.S. Department of Education's (ED's) central database for student aid. NSLDS receives data from schools, guaranty agencies, the Direct Loan program, and other Department of ED programs. NSLDS Student Access provides a centralized, integrated view of Title IV loans and grants so that recipients of Title IV Aid can access and inquire about their Title IV loans and/or grant data.

How Do I Find My Loans?

1. Go to https://www.nsls.ed.gov/nsls/nsls_SA/
2. Click on the link that says "Financial Aid Review"



3. Accept the privacy disclaimer on the next page
4. Either log into the NSLDS with your existing account or click on the tab to Create An FSA ID



5. You will need to provide information such as your name, email address, social security number, and to create up to 5 security questions as well as creating a username and password.
