Rationale:

Education Minnesota is a SOLIDARITY UNION standing with all those fighting for freedom, justice, equality and dignity. On November 4, 2020, Minneapolis Police, Hennepin County Sheriffs and Minnesota Highway Patrol have recently made mass arrests of over 600 protesters, kettling protesters and not giving dispersal orders.
