## 5. Board of Directors. Monica Byron

Membership: 6,806 members at this point.

Everything through EdMN is in good standing. Revenue at 52.4%

Dues will increase by \$10 next year. They will go from \$463.00 to \$473.00. The average salary in Mn is \$67,412.00 (An increase of 6.73% from previous year>) Racial Justice planning committee. Just sent out a survey and they will compile the data to report back. How people are engaged

within locals and community. What can we do moving forward as the result of the survey.

### 6. Council Chairs:

Melissa Benjamin, Communications: The website is up to date.

David Clark, Gov Relations. A tentative agreement with the Governor and the legislators. Waiting to hear what it is. Marc Doepner-Hove, Negotiations. Waiting to hear what the state funding will be. Marc is sharing a document where he would like you to enter "new strategies" for negotiations this coming year.

Where should we hold our relicensure event this year? A central location? Also a virtual offering. Let's take this up at our August planning session. Will people be up for an in person training? Reengagement seminar? Mix of re engagement and relicensure?

#### 8. Adam Janiak. EdMN

All the federal funds that have come from the Rescue America Plan, field staff has the info now. The money can be used for stipends, premiums (bonus).

There are districts that want to reward their staff for the hard year they just completed. EdMN is tracking this statewide. Let Adam or Beth know if your district is going to give premiums.

# 9. Ethnic Studies Initiative Coalition. ECCS has 3 facilitators lined up to work with Chaska members this summer. Well attended. People enjoyed it. Think they will try this again this fall in person.

Next year is Westonka's 75<sup>th</sup> birthday. Shirts will be made up and deep dives into the contract to highlight advances that have been made over the last 75 years will be highlighted. Member engagement will take on a whole look this coming year. Minnetonka LEMURS will have an informal pre-school meet.
