More pension bills are coming!

We have it on good authority that the TRA legislative proposal will be introduced in the next week, and will be used as the “vehicle” bill for end-of-session negotiations. This means the bill with the TRA components will be used as a starting point for discussions, and will be amended as legislators make their final decisions. As we’ve mentioned in the past, any pension improvements are highly dependent on the budget target given to the LCPR. We’re very excited to hear that more options are on the table!

Member advocacy opportunity

Our staff had very productive meetings with LCPR members this week. We discussed our strong support for our bill, TRA’s proposal and getting as many options on the table as possible. We also shared the need for larger budget targets as well as giving more members an opportunity to connect directly with legislators.

To that end, we’re excited to share a new opportunity for Education Minnesota members to meet with LCPR Chair Rep. Kaohly Vang Her and Rep. Dan Wolgamott, lead author of our pension bill ([HF2222](#)) and LCPR member.

We’re hosting a **virtual pension town hall from 5-6 p.m. Wednesday, March 29**. During this time, members will hear from Reps. Her and Wolgamott and get their perspective on pension legislation and the overall legislative landscape.
