Education Minnesota leadership talks pensions with Gov. Walz




On March 11, Education Minnesota leadership had a very productive conversation with Gov. Tim Walz regarding teacher pensions. President Denise Specht, Secretary-Treasurer Rodney Rowe, and PAG co-chairs Ryan Fiereck and Lisa Olson emphasized the pressing need for immediate action on pensions.

The governor committed to working and fighting together for better pensions this year. In a year where few items got new funding, Gov. Walz demonstrated his commitment to this issue with a \$55 million allocation to public sector pensions in his initial budget. He reiterated that commitment in our meeting, as well as his desire to work closely with Education Minnesota on this issue.

Teacher pension clone bills introduced

Education Minnesota's original pension bills (HF1582/SF2000) have now reached the maximum number of authors allowed! Because of this, we have introduced "clone bills" in the Senate, <u>SF2523</u>, and House, <u>HF 2341</u>, which will allow us to get more legislators to show their support by signing on. This is the same bill as originally introduced.
