Educators flood the Capitol for Pensions Day of Action



Educators turned out in force for Tuesday's Pensions Day of Action. Over 140 members traveled far and wide to attend the day of action in St. Paul, with many more attending the Pension Commission hearing that evening. The day included nearly 70 meetings with legislators on both sides of the aisle, ending with a panel discussion featuring members of the Legislative Commission on Pensions and Retirement.

As part of this discussion, President Denise Specht made it clear: Minnesota teachers need a career rule and we need it THIS YEAR!

With the House and Senate currently debating the upcoming state budget and how much funding will be allocated for teacher pensions, we must act now. In particular, the initial budget targets released by the Senate are woefully inadequate and leadership needs to hear from us about it.
