It is almost time! Next **Tuesday, April 8**, Education Minnesota is hosting a Pensions Day of Action from **11 a.m. to 5 p.m. (NEW start and end times)** to

lobby legislators to support our 2025 pension reform bill.

We will meet at [Christ Lutheran Church on Capitol Hill](#) in St. Paul for a briefing and then walk to the Minnesota State Capitol. Legislators need to hear directly from teachers about the need for improved pensions, and this is our chance.

As part of this day of action, we are asking members to stay and attend the Legislative Commission on Pensions and Retirement meeting at 5 p.m. Our teacher pension bill will be heard by the Commission that evening, and we need your help to pack the room.
