

The next meeting of the Legislative Commission on Pensions and Retirement is Tuesday, May 6 at 5:30 pm and the committee will be discussing the omnibus pensions bill. With weeks left in the legislative session, this meeting is our next best opportunity to speak with legislators and demand a teacher career rule this year. All final decisions on pension funding are on hold until joint budget targets are reached by the House, Senate and Governor.

Interested members should plan to meet at the Education Minnesota office at 5 p.m. and we will walk to the 5:30 p.m. meeting together. The hearing will be held in Room 123 in the Capitol Building.
